Cowichan District Hospital Site Rezoning Public Meeting

The Municipality of North Cowichan Council gave 2nd reading to the Zoning Bylaw which will allow us to proceed with the new hospital project. The next step is to hold a Public Hearing which is now scheduled for **Wednesday**, **June 29**th **at 6 pm** at the North Cowichan Council Chambers.

The Public Hearing is a very important step in the process as it allows for anyone who has an interest in the bylaw (for or against) to express their opinion on whether it should proceed or not! As such, it is very important if you support this project moving that you attend this meeting and if you feel compelled, say a few words in support of the bylaw and the project. If you represent a club or

organization, please mention that in your presentation because numbers and community groups really matter in these situations.
